1. Enrollment form one - Fill form in CAPITAL LETTERS / Sign and bring it with you.
2. Enrollment Form Two - Fill BLUE & PURPLE sections if applicable with **+**. Sign and bring it with you.
3. Hippa Privacy Notice - For your use only! Sign only Notice Acknowledgment and bring it with you.
4. Sign Consent for blood drawing and bring it with you.
5. USCIS Medical Exam Instructions sheet- For your use only!

★ Leave questionable portion blank! Discuss queries with staff or physician during your appointment!

★ **Bring your original I.D. – Driver’s License or State I.D. or Passport or Consular I.D. or School I.D. [MANDATORY]**

USCIS MEDICAL EXAM INSTRUCTIONS: BEFORE EXAM

1. Alien number and S.S. # if available [**OPTIONAL**]
2. Records of Childhood Vaccinations - if available- Please **do not waste time in getting old records freshly written by physicians in your country.**
3. Ask your parents or Elderly, if you have had Chicken Pox at any age [VARICELLA] - [YES OR NO]
4. Please inform the doctor if you had BCG vaccine in Child hood.

Please inform the doctor if you are pregnant, suspect pregnancy, trying for pregnancy, or on

Fertility medications. [MANDATORY]

DURING EXAM

- 1 Wear non fitting loose clothes especially both arms for possible vaccinations.
- 2 Fasting is not necessary unless you wish to undergo additional sugar or cholesterol check.
- 3 For patients 15 yrs or above age- blood test will be drawn for RPR testing. [MANDATORY]
- 4 2-3 vaccines may be given depending on the blood report of the patient- at additional costs.
- 5 **Placed T.B. Skin Test has to be read in 2-3 days or needs to be repeated. [MANDATORY] UNLESS!** You have been treated in the past for active Tuberculosis, or had positive P.P.D. And have completed treatment with antibiotics. **BRING PROOF!**

POST EXAM INSTRUCTIONS

1. If Skin Test for T.B. is placed, follow up in 48-72 hrs. Is mandatory to evaluate skin test.
2. Chest X-ray will be required at additional costs, for 5mm or more induration [MANDATORY]

3. You may develop mild fever or little redness and swelling at the site of injections, which may subside in 2-3 days?
4. You may develop some kind of purplish or bluish discoloration at the blood site Drawing, this will subside on its own in 1-2 weeks. No need to treat.
5. You may choose to take 2 Advil or Tylenol 2-3 times a day, for pain and swelling. Apply cold pack to the site of swelling, followed in 24hours by warm pack.

MOST IMPORTANT!!

1. Medical Exam for U.S. Immigration is only to be performed by USCIS Certified Civil Surgeon at USCIS Certified Medical Center.
2. Do not open the sealed envelope given by the Civil Surgeon.
3. Exact copy of the records will be provided to you and your attorney at no costs.
4. Medical Exam for immigration is valid for One Year.

Occasionally, Final report may be delayed due to unseen problems of requiring additional confirmatory blood tests, X-rays findings or delay in the lab results of immunity titers. In this event we would highly appreciate your patience! Extra follow up visits may be required. Every effort will be made to procure your results in timely manner!

FOR PREGNANT PATIENT OR PATIENT ON FERTILITY MEDICATIONS OR WHO IS DOUBTFUL ABOUT PREGNANCY:

Blood test for RPR, SKIN Test for T.B. is safe. Vaccines like MMR or Varicella are contraindicated! DT and Flu vaccines can be given during pregnancy. You may choose to get a waiver for vaccinations or opt for blood IGG'S testing to prove immunity at additional costs. Or produce authentic records of past vaccinations. The waiver is only valid till your delivery date and if your application has not been adjudicated till that time than USCIS may send RFE [Request for Evidence] for optimizing vaccinations, leading to delay!

FOR PATIENT'S COMING FROM LONG DISTANCE AND DO NOT WANT TO RETURN TO CHECK P.P.D. TESTING 2-3 DAYS LATER. OR WISHES TO FINISH PROCESS IN ONE SITTING.

For patients having documented positive testing for skin test in the past, no need to repeat P.P.D. again. You may undergo Chest X-ray and finish your process same day with results mailed to you in 48hrs. But you must present documented proof showing dates when T.B. Skin test placed, read and how many mm of induration on doctor's or medical authority letter head.

OR

You may also choose to undergo Blood tests for Tuberculosis Screen [IGRA] at additional costs. If Negative, you do not need to come back or go for x-rays. If positive, you have to undergo Chest X-ray to screen further for Tuberculosis.

FED- EX – Bring Express mail prepaid, preaddressed envelop for urgent mailing. ITEMIZED BILL can be requested for Insurance Reimbursement. We do not bill insurance.
